Conference theatre

Our spacious conference theatre can seat 120 in theatre style seating or 60 in cabaret or classroom arrangements. We can also accommodate other layouts. It can be hired by the day or half-day.

Seminar rooms

Our two modern seminar rooms seat 16 in boardroom style or can be used for larger groups with a theatre style layout. They can be hired by the day, half-day or hour.



Meeting rooms

Our four meeting rooms seat ten people each and are ideal for small breakout sessions. They can be hired by the day, half-day or hour.

Our meet and mingle area lets guests eat, drink and circulate surrounded by polar science exhibits. With a dedicated refreshments area, it can accommodate comprehensive buffet-style catering. It's also an ideal space for posters.

Hybrid



All our state-of-the-art spaces are fully optimised for hybrid events with a large display screen and video conferencing technology. The conference theatre is ideal for hybrid events with lectern, panel, lapel, handheld, throwable and ceiling microphones available. There are also speaker, panel, room, handheld and manually positionable camera views so everyone can be seen and heard.



We can provide extension leads, ethernet connections and a laptop for presentations. Wifi is available to all visitors and printing is available in moderate quantities. We can help with setting up technology but management through the event is the responsibility of the organiser. IT support is available if there are problems. Filming and photography at your event must be agreed beforehand and a formal agreement must be made.



Food and drink



In line with our ethos of environmental stewardship and sustainability, we have committed to serving low-carbon, vegetarian and vegan options. Carbon data is available for all our options.

We can offer everything from teas and coffees to full lunches and can be very flexible to your requirements. Please get in touch to discuss further.

Although we can't sell alcohol on the premises, you can bring alcohol on site—we can provide wine glasses.




